1 PPP Scheduler Changes

This update includes the following changes in Scheduler:

- Customizable working hour values for project calendars 
- Bug fix: Wrong display of filtered list
- Bug fix: 8.5h configuration does not work in resource plan 
- Added fields from the Add Column list remain visible after refresh 
- Update Site Navigation with new Report Pack 
- Bug fix: Error when changing any baseline column value 
- Bug fix: Task ID displayed correctly in Predecessor column 

1.1 Customizable working hour values for project calendars

With this update, TPG Scheduler supports customizable hours per day and days per month values for project calendars that differ from the default values of 8 hours per day and 5 days per week. It is now possible to customize these settings to meet project requirements.

Example: The value for the hours per day is set to 8.5.

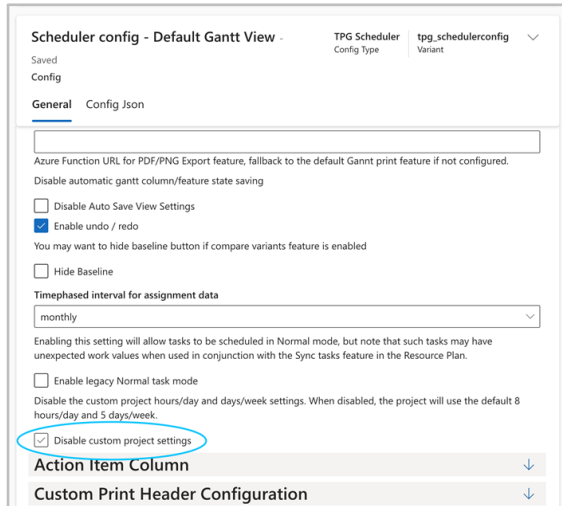

▶ A new task that is planned for 1 day has an effort of 8.5 hours instead of the previous default value of 8 hours.

This function can be deactivated by administrators in the settings:

- Select the “Deactivate user-defined project settings” checkbox.

- ▶ After the upgrade, this setting is activated by default, i.e. if the default calendar is not configured with 8 hours per day, all projects are automatically rescheduled the next time they are opened!

1.2 Bug fix: Wrong display of filtered list

After opening a project from a filtered list and clicking on the back button of the browser, no projects were displayed. This update ensures that the quick search filter works correctly when navigating back to the project list after opening a project with filters applied.

1.3 Bug fix: 8.5h configuration does not work in resource plan

If user create a project with an 8.5-hour calendar, add a one-day task, and assign it to a resource, then synchronize the Resource Plan (including work and overwrite), the task will change to 1.06 days.

This issue has been resolved, and you can now configure the hours per day in sync to any numeric value.

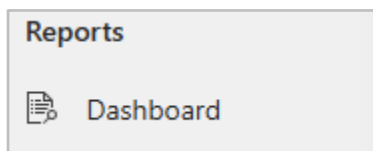
1.4 Added fields from the Add Column list remain visible after refresh

The Baseline Start and Finish columns should always be visible in the Scheduler, even after a refresh. In the previous version, users have to manually add these columns, and they disappear after refreshing.

This issue has been fixed and now all added columns are visible after a refresh.

1.5 Update Site Navigation with new Report Pack

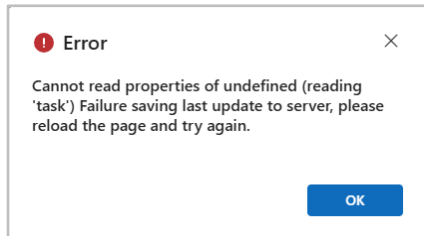
With version PPP Scheduler 2.9, the site navigation has been updated. The new report package has a single entry page that must be used instead of the previous individual report links for request, portfolio, project and resource.



The old reports are still available in the Site Navigation of the previous versions.

1.6 Bug fix: Error when changing any baseline column value

In the previous version, changing any baseline column value caused an error message.

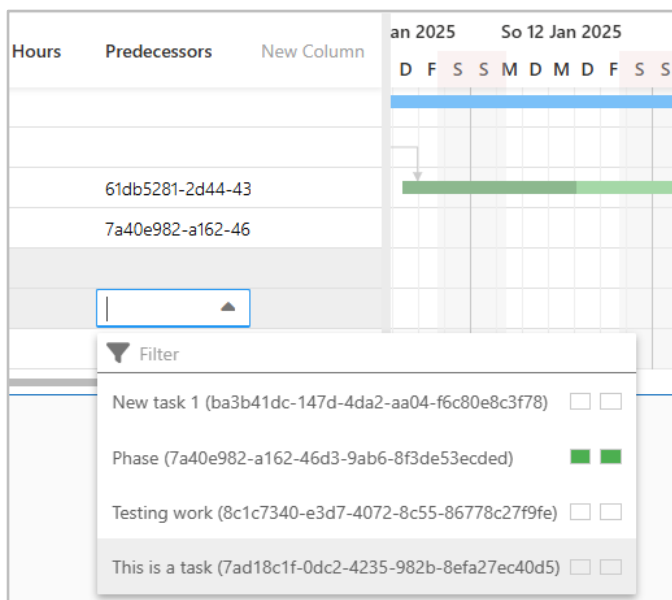


These columns should not be editable.

This issue has now been fixed: Baseline Start and Finish columns are made read-only and can only be set when configuring the baseline from the Baseline menu.

1.7 Bug fix: Task ID displayed correctly in Predecessor column



Predecessor column in Multi-Scheduler shows a GUID and not the sequence number of the predecessor task.



This bug has been fixed: Predecessor column now correctly shows the task ID and not the GUID.

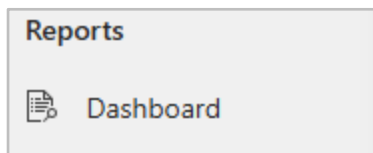
2 PPP Planner Premium Changes

This update includes the following changes in Planner Premium:

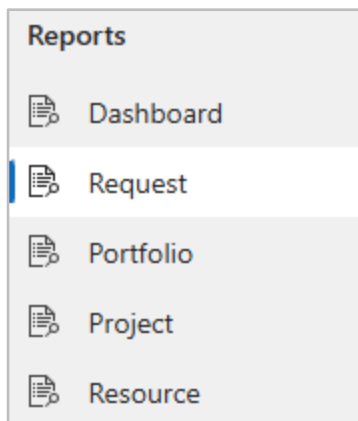

2.1 Update Site Navigation with new Report Pack

With version PPP 2.9, the site navigation has been updated. The new report package has a single entry page that must be used instead of the previous individual report links for request, portfolio, project and resource.



The old reports are still available in the Site Navigation of the previous versions.



2.2 Bug fix: Risk can not be saved

In the previous version, a risk couldn't be saved. An error message appeared when a risk was created with both Likelihood and Consequence set to 1. Both sliders were set to 1 by default. If the slider was moved forward and then back to 1, it worked.




3 Advanced Grid Changes

3.1 Bug Fix: Tooltip Shows Days with 8.5h Config

In the previous version, when the availability factor (availFactor) was changed to a number other than 8 (the default) to configure the plan to hours mode, the values in the tooltip were mistakenly assumed to be in days.

This Bug has been fixed: The values in the tooltip should be displayed in days only when the availability factor is set to its default value (1). For any other value, the values should be displayed in hours instead.

3.2 Bug Fix: Synchronization of resource plan

In the previous version, the sync of the resource plan caused an error. This bug has been fixed and the sync now works correctly.

4 Kanban

This update includes the following changes in Kanban:

- **Bug Fix: Error When Deleting Action Linked to Task** 

4.1 Bug Fix: Error When Deleting Action Linked to Task

In the previous version, when an action linked to a task was deleted, an error message appeared, and the action was still visible. First, the page had to be refreshed, and then the action disappeared.

This issue has been resolved. Now, there is no error, and the action is immediately removed.
